

1. About cookies

Cookies are small data files which are downloaded to your device when you visit our website. Cookies may gather information about your use of the website or may enable us to recognise you as an existing customer when you return to our website at a later date. Cookies allow us to recognise your device. You can find more information about cookies at http://www.youronlinechoices.eu.

You do not have to accept (all of) our cookies. However, if you do not accept or delete our cookies, some areas of our website may take more time to work, or may not function properly. You can find more information on how to disable and/or delete cookies in section 4 below.

2. What types of cookies are used?

We use both session and persistent cookies on our website. These cookies are:

- Strictly necessary cookies: These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.
- **Preference cookies**: Or "functionality cookies," these cookies allow our website to remember choices you have made in the past, like what language you prefer, or what your username and password are so you can automatically log in.
- **Statistics cookies**: Or "performance cookies," these cookies collect information about how you use our website, like which pages you visited, and which links you clicked on. None of this information can be used to identify you. It is all anonymized.
- Marketing cookies: These cookies are used to deliver personalized ads to visitors based on
 previously visited pages and to analyze the effectiveness of advertising campaigns. These cookies
 can share that information with other organizations or advertisers. These are persistent cookies
 and almost always of third-party provenance.
